- 3. Lender of Last Resort to SACCOs (incl. emergency loans)
- 4. Central Finance Fund lending arm
- 5. CFF's Green Energy Fund (Cookstoves, Solar, Solar Irrigation)

## SOLAR IRRIGATION PILOT

### I. Target Number of SACCOs

10 SACCOs identified as beneficiaries of the Pilot.

Selection dependent on the SACCO's ability to mobilize at least 5 members to patronize Solar Water Pump Loan (SWPL).

## 4. MAXIMUM LOAN & LOAN STRUCTURE

Maximum Loan available per SACCO-member is Kshs. 150,000 (equivalent to total cost of the preferred pump, accessories, and installation)

KUSCCO on-lends to SACCO at 10% for up to 2 years

## 5. PARTNERS

Winrock provided Technical Assistance – design loan product, matching with pump suppliers, green energy unit strategy, partner linking

KUSCCO mobilizes SACCOs through 5 Regional Officers across the coutnry. SACCOs mobilize farmers.
