SCALE-NRM forms part of the broader USAIDfunded SCALE initiative to improve forest governance, strengthen agribusiness and trade, and enhance infrastructure. Other SCALE partners are DAI, Green Powered Technology, Nathan Associates, and Pacific American Fund.

Objectives

- Empowering communities to effectively participate in decisions about the exploitation of community-owned forests, and to design and implement initiatives to conserve and effectively manage these forests.
- Ensuring increased community economic benefit from the forests they own, through a combination of: (a) income-generating activities; and (b) conservation concessions
- Strengthening the capacity of the Malaita Provincial Government to effectively plan, manage and protect forests, building a network of "Natural Resource Champions" in the national and provincial governments, and sharing the experience of the project in Malaita to other provinces throughout the country.

Implementation Principles

- Communities participate and are able to influence decisions regarding the management of forests in Malaita Province.
- Governments at both the provincial and national level are committed to community-based forest resource management and conservation, and have the policies, procedures, staff, and skills required to implement such policies.
- Women and youth participate in and lead Community-Based Natural Resource Management initiatives.
- A Natural Resource Management Champions Network improves vertical integration of government policies from local, provincial and national levels, as well as horizontal learning between jurisdictions.
- Conservation concession models are developed and implemented, which provide significant, sustainable benefits to communities and influence communities to support forest conservation.
- An effective forest monitoring mechanism is developed that incorporates ground level monitoring and remote data collection, and provides real-time forest information, which is accessible to the widest possible range of stakeholders.
